

What do we deliver?

- ♀ **Community Development Service** – Our dedicated Community Development Workers cover all areas of Leeds and are available to attend events, give presentations, facilitate drop in sessions and arrange outreach sessions to organisations around a variety of topics for women. They can signpost to other services in the city and provide information and advice.
- ♀ **Complex Needs Service** – Our committed Complex Needs Workers work directly with women and girls with complex and multiple needs. They provide one to one intensive support and take a holistic approach to meet their specific needs.
- ♀ **Virtual Women's Centre** – This will be a single point of information for all you need to know about services and support available to women and girls in Leeds. This will be an online resource and available to everyone. This resource is currently being developed and will be launching in autumn 2017

How can you use these services?

- ♀ In order to access the Complex Needs Service, you need to be accessing one of our partner services, check our website for a list of partner organisations. This service can then refer you into the WLL Complex Needs Service if appropriate.
